When we use the word '**welcome**' as an address in India we say '**Swagatam**'

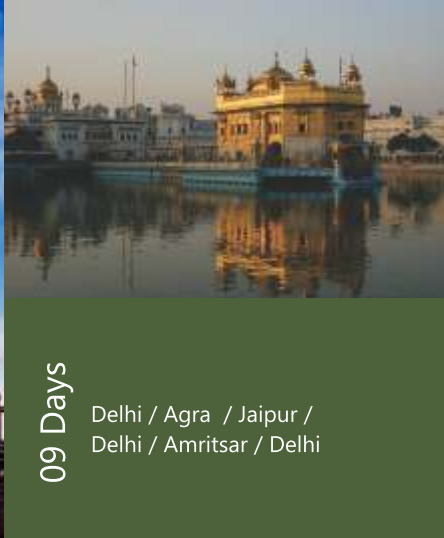

Golden Triangle - Delhi, Agra, Jaipur

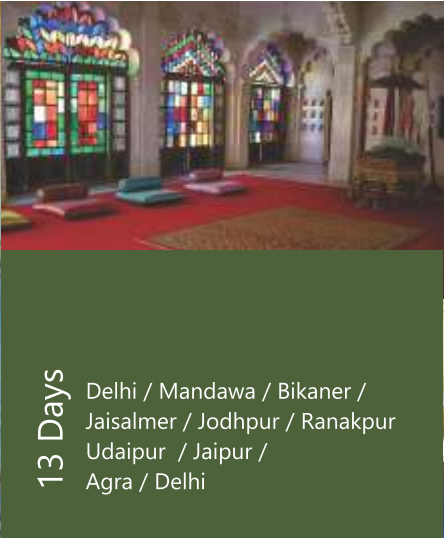
